

REHABILITATION PROGRAMS



Grazing trial cattle on rehabilitated land at New Acland Mine

A diversified energy company based in south-east Queensland since 1952, New Hope Group is an industry leader in best practice rehabilitation of open-cut coal mines and is committed to the progressive rehabilitation of disturbed land across its operations. In 2016 New Hope won the Australian Business Awards ABA100 Sustainability Award for its rehabilitation practices.

New Acland Mine – Darling Downs

New Hope has been progressively rehabilitating New Acland Mine since operations began in 2002.

Rehabilitation commences immediately behind mining operations. Around 490Ha of mined land is rehabilitated.*

240Ha of the rehabilitated land is now grazing ~75-100 cattle.

Five years of scientific cattle grazing trials conducted on the rehabilitated land indicate cattle on mined land perform as well, or better than, cattle on unmined land.

Jeebropilly Mine – Ipswich

Progressive rehabilitation at New Hope's Jeebropilly Mine has seen almost 459Ha of land rehabilitated, with cattle grazing on western areas of the mining lease for more than 15 years.

Chuwar – Ipswich

In 2013 New Hope commenced rehabilitation of mined land at the former Chuwar Mine.

In 2017 full rehabilitation of the former mine site, which included 30Ha of mined land, was completed.

New Oakleigh West - Ipswich

New Hope completed mining operations at New Oakleigh West in 2014.

In 2017 rehabilitation was completed at the former mine site, which included around 223Ha of mined land.



As of January 2018, New Hope had rehabilitated a total of 45% of mined land across its Queensland operations.
