Safety Share	<ul> <li>NAC GM noted an increase of speed cameras and police presence on the roads within the district and encouraged people to continue to drive safely.</li> <li>General group discussion around recent bush fires in the district and the 'increased risk' associated with the ongoing dry environment.</li> </ul>
New Acland Coal Mine Update	<ul> <li>NAC GM provided update to group.</li> <li>NAC Stage 3 ramp-up gained certainty with the withdrawal of the Oakey Coal Actional Alliance (OCCA) stay application on 15th August 2023.</li> <li>NAC proceeding with plans to mine coal from Manning Vale East Pit with projection for first coal transportation to be in October 2023 from Jondaryan Rail Loadout Facility (JRLF).</li> <li>NAC working with rail providers on transport of coal.</li> <li>Response to tenders from local contractors and businesses has been good.</li> <li>Next intake of employees expected to take place in fourth quarter of 2023 building up to a workforce of 400 full-time roles at peak of construction.</li> </ul>
